Professional Attire:

Preparing for the future!

Professional Attire:

All Senior Level HST students are required to wear what the industry standard / EPCC / and internship sites require.

(A more concise description of requirements will be provided by the instructor)

- EMT students will wear Cargo Pants & Polo or T-Shirt and no open toed shoes.

- MCB students will wear medical scrubs and no open toed shoes.



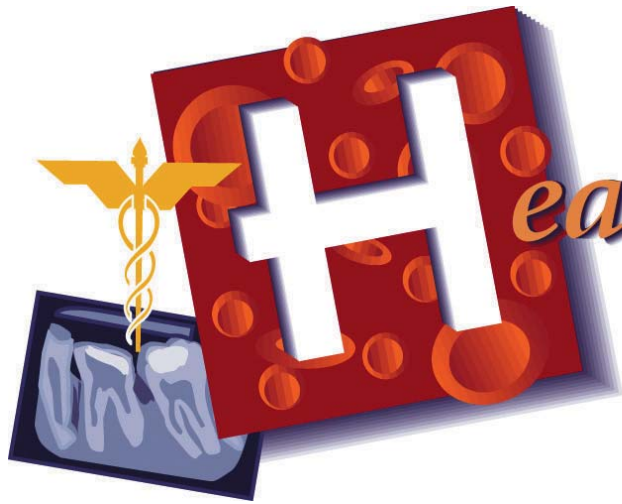

2nd Year Program Selection and Enrollment Process:

- Each 2nd Year program has limited seating due to internship and affiliation requirements.
- All students will be placed according to their GPA earned at CCTE in conjunction with their wish list.
- Students will be given an opportunity to interact with all HST teachers and view each program in action.

HST Senior Year AM Program Options:

- **Certified Nurses Assistant:** (AM Only) Paired w/ MCB
 - **Program Focus:** Offers hands on experience during their clinical rotations at area nursing care facilities.
 - **Certification:** Certified Nursing Assistant exam; cost of this exam is \$93.
 - **Internship:** Mornings at local health care facilities.
 - **Added Value:** Articulated course w/ EPCC:
(HPRS 2332 Health Care Communications)

HST Senior Year AM Program Options:

- **Medical Coding & Billing:** (AM Only) *Paired w/ CNA*
 - **Program Focus:** Offers hands on experiences in a hospital medical administrative (Sierra Medical Center or Providence Memorial Hospital). Students work with medical records, learn the PBX hospital phone answering system, work in the Admitting Office, or in the Health Occupations office. Students may experience time the pre-op department, the new-born or post-partum nursery.
 - **Certification:** Insurance Coding Specialist through NCCT; Cost is approx. \$90.00.
 - **Internship:** Mornings at local health care facilities.

- **Pharmacology:** (AM Only)
 - **Program Focus:** Offers hands on experience at local area pharmacies.
 - **Certification:** IV Certification (\$250)
 - **Certification:** Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam (\$129)
 - **Internship:** Mornings at local pharmacies.
 - **Added Value:** Articulated course w/ EPCC:
 - (PHRA 1301 Introduction to Pharmacy)
 - (PHRA 1309 Pharmaceutical Mathematics 1)

HST Senior Year PM Program Options:



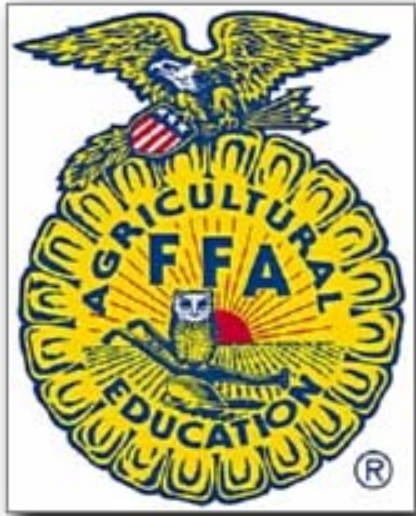
- **Emergency Medical Technician:** (PM Only) *Dual Credit Only*
 - **Program Focus:** Offers hands on experience in emergency medical care.
 - **Certification:** National Registry for Emergency Medical Techs (NREMT); cost is approximately \$70.
 - **Internship:** Evenings and Weekends at local Trauma Centers and on Ambulances.
 - **Added Value:** Dual Credit course w/ EPCC:
 - EMSP 1501 Emergency Medical Technician-Basic
 - EMSP 1160 Clinical-Emergency Medical Technician



HST Senior Year PM Program Options:

- **Sports Medicine:** (PM Only)
 - **Program Focus:** Offers hands on experiences in physical therapy, athletic training, physiology of exercise, kinesiology, fitness and nutrition, injury prevention, and other sports medicine related fields. Internships offer experience with the treatment and rehabilitation of sports injuries, taping and wrapping of injuries, NSC First Aid/CPR-AED, and emergency procedures.
 - **Internship:** Afternoons and/or weekends at local health care & rehab facilities.

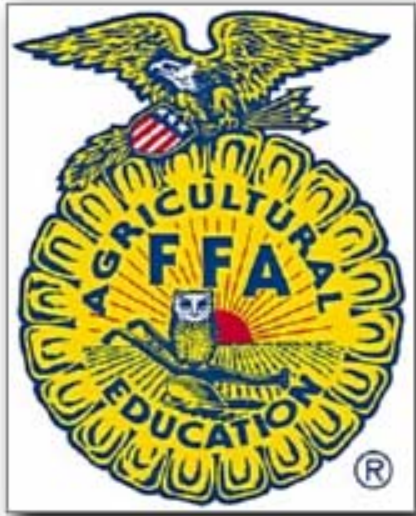

VST Senior Year Overview:

- **Senior Year:**
 - **Program Focus :** Focus on large animal husbandry, genetics and breeding, as well as the practicum serving as an internship in a clinical setting. A total of 500 hours is required of both the classroom and the clinical practice to apply for certification as a Veterinary Assistant.
 - **Certification:** Texas Veterinary Medical Association Certification; Cost is approximately \$125.
 - **Internship:** Mornings, afternoons, and weekends at local animal clinics.

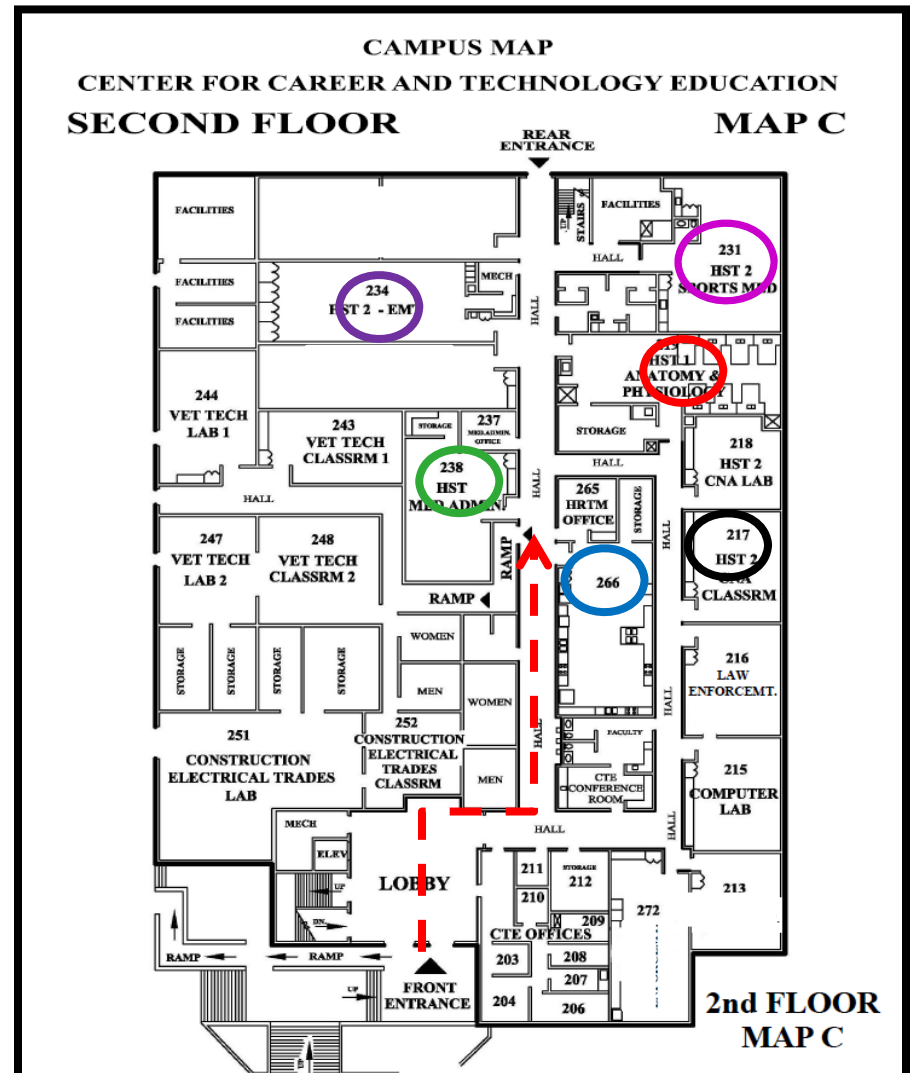

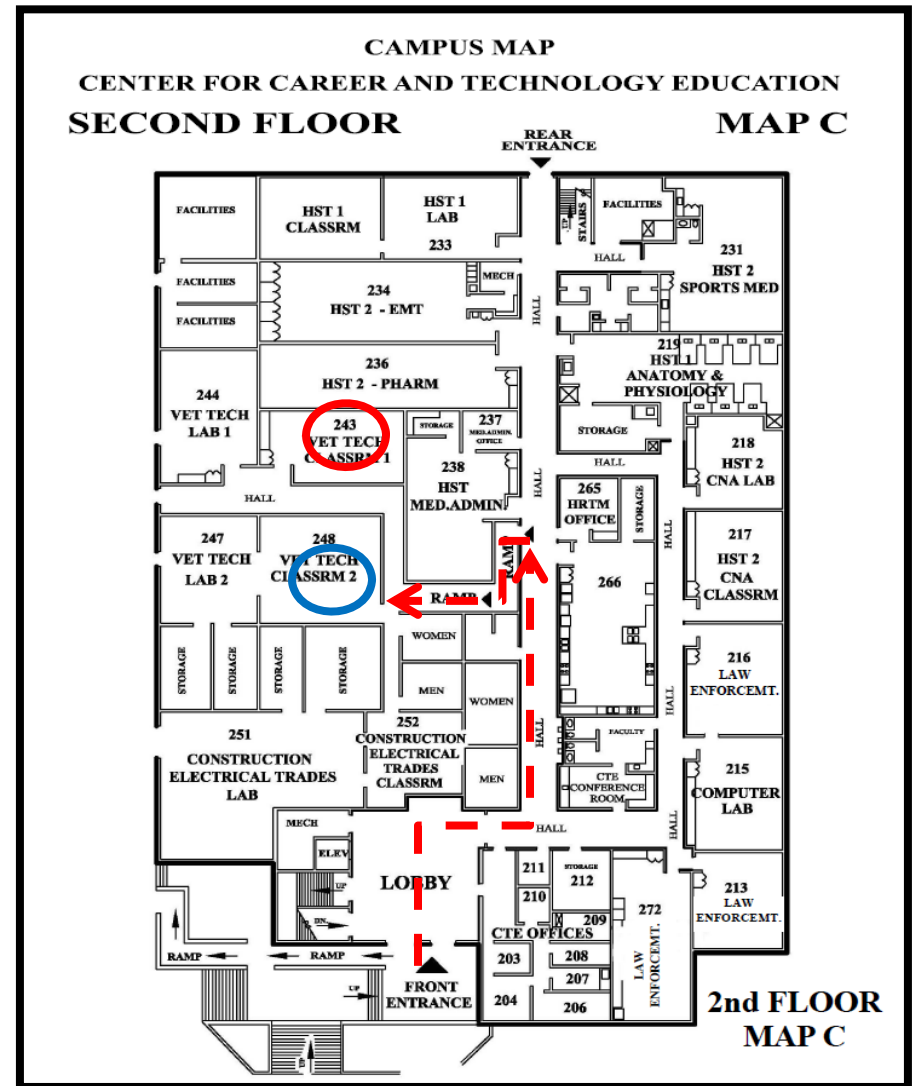
